# How To Find Us

If travelling from Skipton towards Broughton Hall along the A59, you will pass The Bull pub on the left hand side. Opposite The Bull (on your right) is Gargrave Road, signposted Gargrave. Turn right onto Gargrave Road.

After passing a row of cottages on your left then a row of cottages on your right, you will see an unmarked tarmacked road on your left just before the road bends round to the right, this is Old Lane. Turn left down Old Lane and follow the road around. Pass the woodland on your right and keep going until you see the carpark ahead. Our car park is the smaller one of the two located here. **(What3Words location soonest.interrupt.bracing)** 

On foot, follow the signposted, mown path across the field to get to the woodland entrance. Please do not walk along the road as this makes it dangerous for the children & other drivers.
