The cheapest (and very effective) way of getting rid of head lice is to buy cheap hair conditioner and comb this through the hair using a nit comb. You must remember to do this daily for more than a week to get rid of any eggs that might have hatched.

## Reading Morning 21st October @ 9am

We will be holding a reading morning for parents of Apple and Ash to go through how children are taught phonics and reading skills across the EYFS and KS1 (approximately 30 minutes). There will be information on the phonics screening check, reading skills and SATs. This has been a useful session for parents in the past to understand how we teach phonics.
