Head Lice

We have been informed of a case of head lice in Apple class. Please check your child's hair and treat as necessary. The cheapest (and very effective) way of getting rid of head lice is to buy cheap hair conditioner and comb this through the hair using a nit comb. You must remember to do this daily for more than a week to get rid of any eggs that might have hatched.
