Safeguarding

Filtering and monitoring systems are used to keep pupils safe when using school's IT systems. They both serve to safeguard young people in the digital realm—but they are different. Here at Gargrave School, we use Smoothwall which protects students with real-time filtering that blocks harmful content without restricting their freedom to explore and learn. The challenge for any educational organisation is to keep students safe, without compromising their ability to access a rich and dynamic online learning experience. Smoothwall is the safest, most purchased filter in UK Education.

Filtering is a content restriction measure where we use web content control software (Smoothwall) to proactively restrict access to websites that are considered inappropriate.

Monitoring enables us to identify and intervene with issues concerning inappropriate access or searches.
