

#### **Curriculum and Staffing**

We are sending out curriculum plans and timetables via class e-mails on Fridays. These will be sent from class teachers, Mrs Rigby in Apple class, Mrs McLean in Ash class, Mrs Bowers in Willow class (Mrs Holme is off work following surgery) and Mrs Dawson in Oak class.

The teachers are supported by amazing external staff; PE by Mr Mukherjee, Mr Bullock (Fire house Dance) and Mr Schindler (KANGA sports). Year 3 and Year 4 shall swim for this term, taught by Craven Pool staff and Miss Heseltine. They all provide expert tuition across the year groups in a wide range of PE curriculum.

Music lessons for Willow and Oak classes are led by Mrs Evans. External peripatetic lessons are available through the music service in piano, guitar, and violin—there is a charge for this unless in receipt of pupil premium funding. Mr Hinchcliffe also provides accordion lessons and there is currently funding for 10 free lessons. Please ask Mrs Aldous for more details.

Teaching Assistants support learning in all the classes. We also have an amazing group of volunteer readers who listen to individuals read across the school. Please speak to Mrs Aldous if you, or you know of anyone else who might be interested in a volunteer role.

### Raving Readers 2024-2025

Research has proven that regular reading helps children to make progress in ALL areas of the curriculum.

Each class has a 'Raving Readers' chart in the classroom. Each time a child reads their school book or Whole Class Guided Reading text (at the weekend) at home they get to move their name along the chart. All reading MUST be recorded in planners (including page numbers) and signed by an adult; these are checked daily. We are awarding a maximum of one move per day. Our school expectation is that children read at home at least 5 times per week.

#### **Annual Data Forms**

Your child has been given an envelope today which has a number of forms that need completing and returning to school as soon as possible so we have the correct information/consent on file for you and your child. Please check you have completed both sides where necessary.

#### The School Gateway

Payments to school must be made via The School Gateway (<a href="https://login.schoolgateway.com/0/auth/login">https://login.schoolgateway.com/0/auth/login</a>). This includes dinner money for children in Y3-Y6, swimming, trips and Triangle Club. We do not accept cash unless it is fundraising.

Lunch money should **ALWAYS** be in credit to avoid the need to bring a packed lunch. The cost is £2.95 per day or £14.75 per week.

Triangle Club sessions must be booked and paid for at the time of booking via The School Gateway unless you pay by childcare vouchers (please advise Mrs Aldous if you haven't already). 24 hours cancellation notice is required to avoid being charged—please email or phone school.

There is an app you can download for The School Gateway if this works better for you. Please note that you will be notified via the app if any text messages are sent from school as opposed to your usual message app.

#### **Staffing - Communication**

The staff are keen to communicate with families. This can be done face-to-face, via phone call, planners and e-mail. Please be mindful that teachers have classes to teach and so are not always available instantly. If you wish a longer conversation with class teachers, please phone school.

This newsletter is sent out fortnightly on a Thursday and we try and cover a range of whole school news and messages.

Planners are the best way of communicating with class teachers as they are checked every day.

Class teachers send out a weekly e mail on a Friday and this summarises the curriculum for the last week and things coming up. You can reply to this class e mail, but be aware that it may not be checked daily. These are the class email addresses:-

Texts are used, but less frequently, as a reminder or in an emergency.

#### Swimming - Year 5 & 6
