Swimming

Daily Mile

We have launched the daily mile challenge. The idea is that every day the pupils attempt to walk/run a mile, we have measured the path and it is equivalent to 6 times round. Weather permitting this will be encouraged every day this half term, making a maximum of 24 miles!

Safeguarding

At the start and end of the day we need to ensure that there is a clear handover of pupils. Doors open at 8:55am with registration until 9am. Pupils need to be supervised by their adult prior to this unless on the taxi in which case school staff are responsible.
