#### The Return of the King—11th December

The River Aire which runs through Gargrave and other local streams, such as Eshton Beck, provide the nursery grounds where adult salmon breed and lay their eggs. Eventually, from these eggs juvenile salmon will make their way back into the Atlantic where after 3-4 years some will return to Gargrave to breed and the cycle begins again.

To make this a reality, the Environmental Agency and the Aire Rovers Trust (with the support of the Heritage Lottery Fund) will build fish ladders on four weirs on the River Aire in Leeds and Bradford. These special ladders (called fish passes) allow salmon, sea trout, eels and course fish to move freely up and down the river to compete their lifecycle. The local community will be vital in protecting the river for the next generation of salmon.

Our year 6 children have been invited to partake in the making of a promotional film for this project. Gary Verity will also be in attendance.

We have now started family service on Friday lunchtimes. This is a chance for the older children to serve and be responsible for the younger children.
