## Beginning of Term Paperwork

### Data Collection Sheet

You will note that each person has a priority number—this is the order we will use to contact you i.e. number 1 priority is the first contact we will phone, number 2, the second etc. etc. so please amend these to your preference.

Please also note that if we send messages out via the school gateway, we can only text one member in each family—this will always be the number 1 priority so please take this into account when editing.

### Collection

We need this information in order to know who we can release your child too. Parents are automatically included so no need to add. You can always telephone school or write in your child's planner if someone other than who is on the list is collecting your child on a particular day.

### Free School Meals & Pupil Premium Funding (Universal Credit)

We need information about you and your child so that we can provide your child with the best education and support by making sure that we receive all the government funding to which you are entitled.

### School Gateway

Just a reminder that you need to pay for school meals, Triangle club, trips and swimming on the gateway. You should also book your child into Triangle club using this method but please note you must email/telephone school to cancel (24 hours notice required otherwise you will still be charged). Morning sessions run from 7.30-8.55am and afternoon 3.15-6pm.

You will notice an amount next to your child's dinners of £2.30 (even for those children who have packed lunches and a universal free meal). This is purely showing what it would cost IF your child had a school meal and does not mean you owe it. The same goes for Triangle club—it shows the cost should you use it.

Over the next two weeks, any outstanding dinner money and Triangle Club balances from last year will be carried over to this year for you to pay so don't be alarmed if you see a debit and have not used the facility this year.
