

This half term we have been settling in to the class routines and learning about our school. We have all been getting to know each other and finding out about families, interests, abilities and personalities!



These are some of the things we have been doing in Mathematics: working on number recognition, counting and matching accurately, estimating, writing numbers and finding '1 more' than a given number. We have also been finding, naming, using and talking about shapes.



Our 'Storm' paintings (inspired by a night of bad weather in September) are on display outside the classroom. We used dark colours and added lightning using white paint and straws.

In Phonics we have been learning the Jolly Phonics sounds, the actions and writing the letters. We are using sound buttons, CVC words and some high frequency words. The children are really enjoying having their own, individual reading books to take home. Keep reading and record - they are doing GREAT!
