


Ash Class News!

made our own aid to help us with our number bonds to 10. We have enjoyed big sheet maths and using lots of different equipment to help us.


The year 2's have been learning all about place value and using this knowledge to help add 10 to any number. We then used our understanding to add two, two digit numbers



together. Some of us even started adding a two digit number to 3 and 4 digit



numbers!



In Literacy we have been learning about stories with familiar settings. We have written our own stories based on the Tiger Who Came To Tea. We have been working hard to remember our capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We have started learning about describing words and have been using them in our own writing. The year 2's have also been working hard to join some of their writing. We have been working in groups to share ideas, we had to make sure



we took turns and that everyone had chance to share. We have practised using clear loud voices to speak in front of the class.



In theme we have been learning all about ourselves and the local area. We have spoken in front of the class about our families, created our own family trees and made a map to show our journey through the local area from our house to school.
