

Literacy - Monday-Thursday - Mrs Comerford, Friday - Mrs Dawson

Daily: Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar.

Independent reading/reading activities.

Aquila by Simon Norris, Bob The Man on The Moon by Simon Bartram, Space Poems chosen by Gaby Morgan, One Giant Leap (Neil Armstrong) by Don Brown.

Weekly: class to learn and perform a poem.

Skills: Make predictions - what is the story about, what may happen next? Expand vocabulary using dictionaries and thesaurus. Creating a mark scheme. Editing and improving work.

Capturing ideas: 'What if?' activities, hot seating characters, freeze frame key point in the story, conscience alley, zone of relevance, story mountain planning.

Writing Opportunities: Report writing - Archeological report, Newspaper articles. Poetry - based on The Marrog by RC Scriven. Narratives - Adventure Stories.

Mathematics - Monday-Thursday - Mrs Comerford, Friday - Mrs Dawson

Daily: times tables practise to 12 (multiplication and division facts).

Numbers to 1,000,000.

Whole numbers addition and subtraction.

Multiplication and division: factors, prime numbers, square and cubed numbers.

Solving word problems.

Weekly problem-solving (linked to objectives taught Monday-Thursday) and times tables practising and testing (TT Rock Stars).

Gymnastics: choreograph, perform and evaluate a sequence of rolls, jumps and balances to create a sequence titled 'Space'.

Invasion games-develop a range of techniques for passing a ball, perform actions of travelling with, sending and receiving a ball, with greater speed and efficiency, understand and apply rules in games, develop a better understanding of attack and defence.
