

<p>English: Guided reading – weekly Spellings from Year 3&4 list- weekly test Adventure stories Fiction – Rivers, mountains, coasts Recounts Animal Poems</p>	<p>Numeracy: To draw 2-D shapes and make 3-D shapes using modelling materials; recognise 3-D shapes in different orientations and describe them To recognise angles as a property of shape or a description of a turn To identify right angles, recognise that 2 right angles make a half-turn, 3 make three-quarters of a turn and 4 a complete turn; identify whether angles are greater than or less than a right angle To identify horizontal and vertical lines and pairs of perpendicular and parallel lines To measure the perimeter of simple 2-D shapes To add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts To tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII, and 12-hour and 24-hour clocks To estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute; record and compare time in terms of seconds, minutes and hours; use vocabulary such as o'clock, am/pm, morning, afternoon, noon and midnight To know the number of seconds in a minute and the number of days in each month, year and leap year To compare durations of events [for example, to calculate the time taken by particular events or tasks] To compare and order numbers up to 1,000 To identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations To read and write numbers up to 1,000 in numerals and in words To solve number problems and practical problems involving these ideas</p>
