Daily spelling and grammar work.</p> <p>Skills Make predictions – what is the story about, what may happen next, make predictions about the main plot. Infer character’s feelings and emotions, using the text as evidence. Using the idea of the Earth’s rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the Sun across the sky. Predicting day and night in different places on Earth. Describing the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth by explaining how the Moon orbits the Earth.</p>
