

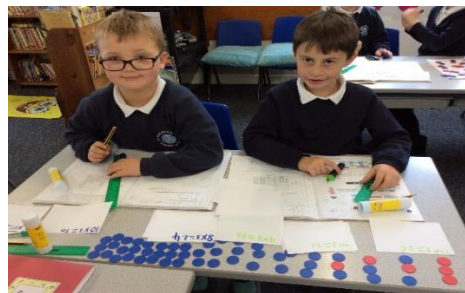
Willow Class Autumn Term Update

We have had a busy and productive start to the Autumn term, following the Year 3 curriculum.

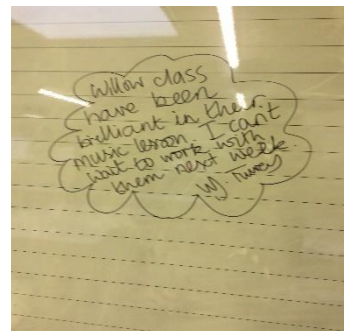
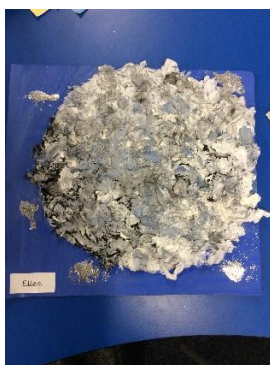

We also identified layout, sentence structure and vocabulary. Our final piece of work was to write a piece of information text of our choice.
