Four Creative Workshops for young people in Gargrave and Malhamdale

Get inspired by artists living in or close to the Yorkshire Dales. Learn techniques in a series of workshops for primary school aged children or young people aged 11 to 18 years.

If you enjoy painting, drawing and think you might like to become an artist or professional creative or just love art then these events are for you. Each artist will talk about their work, show you their work and demonstrate techniques and processes, and then give you the opportunity to have go at producing your own masterpiece.

Support from the Roger Stott Community Grant Scheme, Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust means we can deliver four workshops during 2020 at a cost of just £1.75 per child/young person.



The first event on Saturday 28th March features printmaker, artist and college lecturer Brian Hindmarch. Session 1 at 1.30pm will be for primary school children and Session 2 at 3pm will be for young people aged 11 to 18.

Saturday 28th March kicks off our first workshop to be held in Gargrave Village Hall, featuring artist, printmaker, designer and teacher Brian Hindmarch. Brian has a studio in Ilkley and was a lecturer in Graphic Design at Bradford College, School of Art, for over 20 years.

He uses a wide range of printmaking processes, including photography, etching, letterpress, lithography, screen-print and mono-printing. Brian loves interpreting natural history, environment and landscape in his work and much of his inspiration comes from Yorkshire.



Through my career as a lecturer in Art and Design, I have taught young people of all ages and now I regularly run workshops for those with a passion for art and print-making. On Saturday 28th March I will talk about my practice as an artist and deliver two mono-printing workshops, one for primary school aged children and another for young people aged 11 to 18. All materials will be provided. The theme for the workshops will be 'My place' and could include the following as inspiration, name of village, name of street/house name, what's in my garden, front door, my house, favourite object/tree/plant
